CURRENT SCHOLAR – FUNDING EXTENSION REQUEST

Guidelines for Applicants

This application is to be used only by scholars who meet the following criteria:

- Current New Futures college student in good standing:
 - 2.0 or greater GPA (current & cumulative)
 - Taking at least 2 classes per semester
 - Currently in school (or not out of school for 2 semesters or more)
 - New Futures scholarship balance is less than \$1,500 and one or more semesters of school are still required for the student to complete his or her program of study

- Current New Futures vocational student in good standing:
 - In good academic standing at the educational institute where enrolled
 - Currently in school (or not out of school for 1 year or more)
 - A program-related financial expense has come up that was not originally considered when the scholarship funding was first awarded

*This application is **not** intended for New Futures scholars who are pursuing an additional degree or certification. They should apply for a second New Futures scholarship using the standard Scholarship Application.*

This application should be submitted at least 4 weeks before the start of the semester for which funds are being sought. New Futures will make a decision regarding the request for additional funds and notify the scholar of their decision 2 weeks after the receipt of a completed application. Completed applications should include the following supplemental forms:

- **Current cumulative transcript showing number of credits attempted, credits earned, current GPA and cumulative GPA (Vocational students should provide the closest equivalent to this information such as a report from the school showing the student's progress and academic standing.)**
- **Current financial statement from the educational institute, including information about other sources of financial aid**
- **Financial Plan for remaining education (use the template attached)**

Students must be available to respond to questions which may arise while this application is being considered.
